As a Commercial Photographer & Filmmaker, many of the assignments I work on are necessary for businesses and professionals to stay in communication with their clients.

This can be even more important during times of change and uncertainty.

We have been monitoring the situation closely and instituting practices and procedures to do our part to comply with the latest health and safety procedures and our industry recommendations.

We Agree:

If any crew member is sick or has been in contact with a sick person, they will stay home and if necessary we will contact the client to postpone the session.

Prior to the session we will ask questions to screen crew and clients to ensure that no one is sick, has any symptoms or has been exposed to others with possible COVID-19 symptoms.

We offer access to a hand washing station or disinfectant and we make sure it is used by crew and clients before and after the session.

We wash our hands frequently.

We wear a mask, a face shield, gloves or any combination of these as appropriate.

Sessions are scheduled in advance to allow the cleaning/disinfecting of the studio, set and any equipment.

We keep the number of people on set or location to a minimum and control their movement around the set whenever possible.
